

During the paddle season our organized member-led weekend trips include popular rivers such as the DuPage, Fox, Kishwaukee and Des Plaines Rivers.

RIVER TRIPS

Rated for their difficulty and challenge from Beginner to Expert, more than 100 paddling trips are sponsored annually. Complete descriptions are posted on the website.

WEDNESDAY PADDLES

Every other Wednesday between April - October PSC organizes Wednesday paddle trips to rivers such as the Turtle, Kishwaukee, Sugar, Nippersink, and south branch of the Kishwaukee.

EVENING PADDLES

PSC runs evening paddle trips on the DuPage River and Salt Creek sometimes followed by a social outing.
